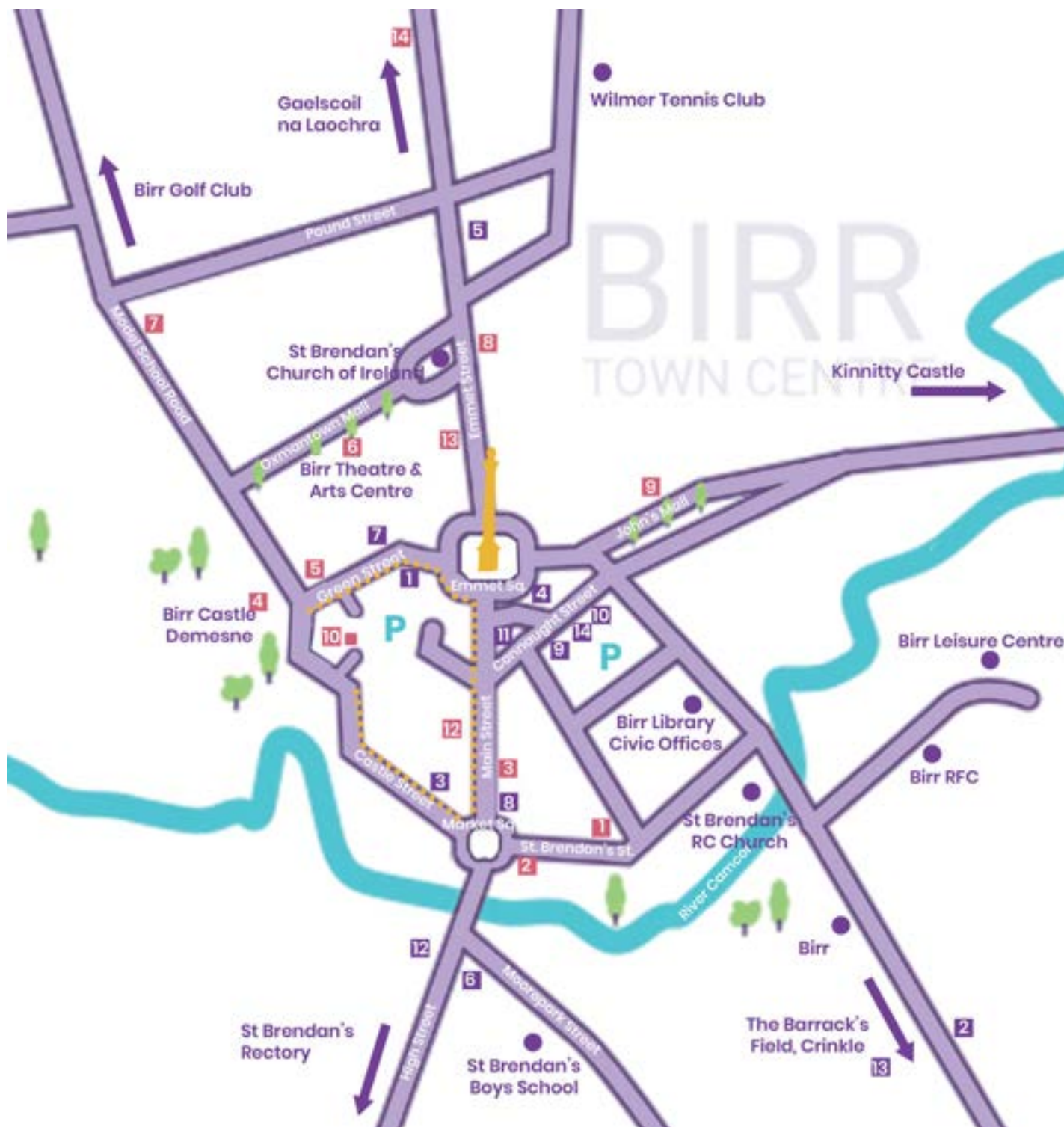

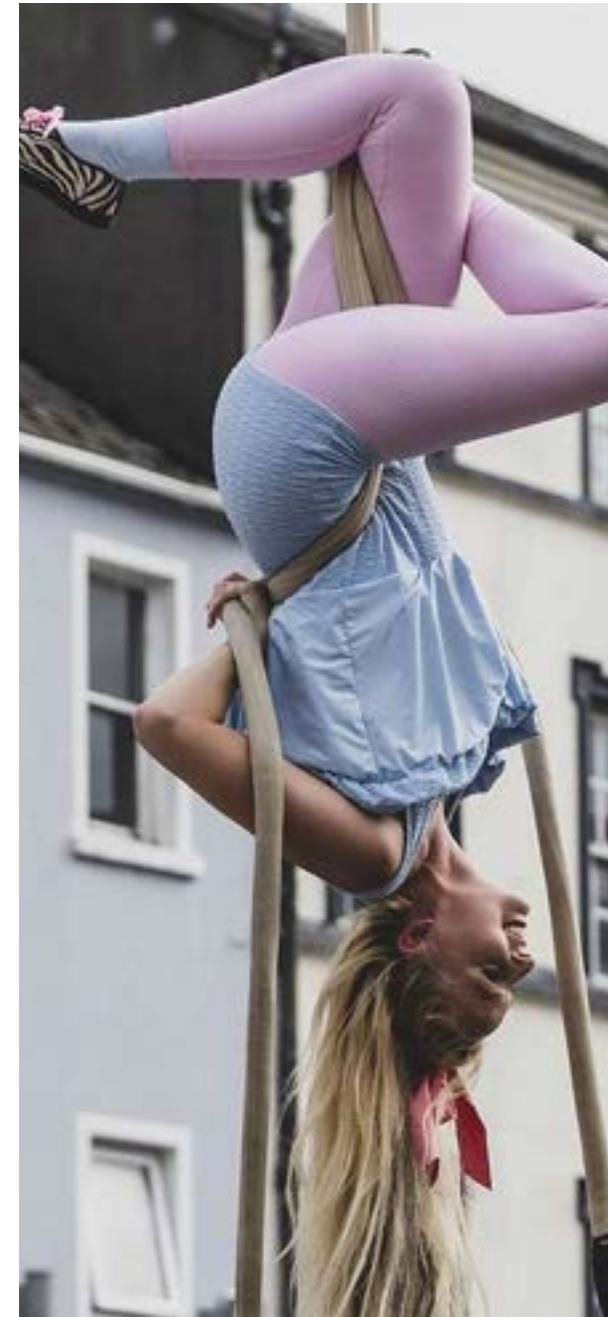

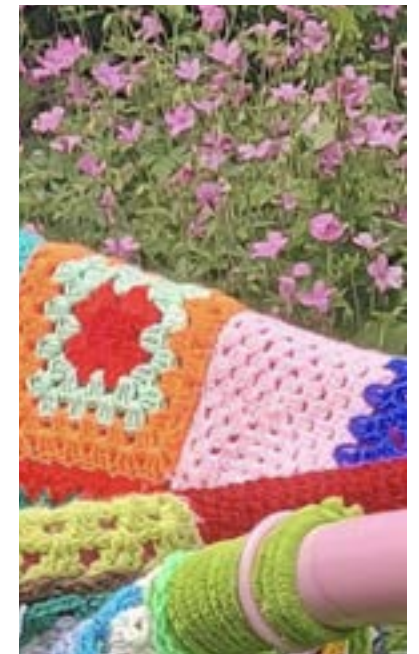

THE ARTS TRAIL

The theme of this year's Arts Trail is **Presence**, the magic of being here, together, in place and time. Throughout the festival, the arts make their presence felt in unexpected ways, with outdoor artworks woven through the town and pop-up performances appearing in public spaces.

As the programme evolved, however, the idea of presence became more intimate and personal, connecting visual art and performance through themes of home, family, memory and domestic life. Vintage Week is a time of homecoming, when people return to familiar places, reconnect with loved ones, and revisit shared stories. This year's Arts Trail celebrates those domestic spaces and histories that quietly shape our lives.

Echoes of domestic ritual and washing appear throughout the programme, from the Main Visual Art Exhibition, *Domestic Mythologies*, to the playful children's event *Out of the Blue*, and *Republic of Silence*, which reflects on the hidden histories and silences embedded within Ireland's institutional past.
